

Controversial ex-Knick Mustaf dead at age 55

Former Knicks first-round pick Jerrod Mustaf, who was embroiled in a murder controversy during his career, died Monday on his 55th birthday, according to the Baltimore Sun.

The cause of death is not yet known, per the report. The Knicks drafted Mustaf with the 17th pick in the 1990 NBA Draft out of Maryland.

The power forward averaged 4.3 points and 2.7 rebounds across 62 games (five starts) in his rookie campaign for a 39-43 Knicks team that the eventual champion Bulls swept in the first round of the 1991 playoffs. That offseason, the Suns acquired him, Trent Tucker and two second-round picks in exchange for Xavier McDaniel.

Mustaf played three seasons with Phoenix, averaging just 3.9 points and 2.4 rebounds across 117 games.

"Nothing about Phoenix was a good fit for me," Mustaf told Sports Illustrated.

During his time there, Mustaf found himself engulfed in controversy after being accused of having his pregnant

girlfriend, Althea Hayes, murdered. Hayes was shot in the head on July 22, 1993, while three months pregnant with Mustaf's child, according to the News & Record.

Mustaf's cousin, LaVonnie Wooten, was convicted of first-degree murder and received a life sentence without parole, according to the Washington Times, but both the prosecution and defense claimed Mustaf masterminded the murder since he wanted Hayes to have an abortion, per the report. The ex-NBAer is alleged by Hayes' family to have offered \$5,000 for her to not have the baby, per a Tucson Citizen report.

The Suns bought out the remaining two years and \$3.8 million remaining on Mustaf's contract in 1994 following the murder, per The New York Times.

Mustaf was never charged with any crime despite the allegations, and he claimed he did not know that Hayes was pregnant, per the outlet. He settled out of court with Hayes' family in 1998 following a wrongful death lawsuit by Hayes' parents, according to the Washington Times.

MLB: WS ratings beat 'MNF'

The World Series beat "Monday Night Football" in the battle for television viewers. The Dodgers' 4-2 victory over the Yankees in Game 3 of the Fall Classic averaged 13.64 million viewers on Fox, Fox Deportes and streaming according to early numbers by Nielsen.

● The White Sox hired **Will Venable** as their new manager Tuesday night, according to multiple reports. Venable, 42, was the Rangers associate manager to **Bruce Bochy** the last two seasons and played a key role for the 2023 World Series title winners.

NBA: Mavs beat T'wolves

Kyrie Irving scored 16 of his 35 points in the third quarter, **Luka Doncic** had a late surge to finish with 24 points, nine assists and eight rebounds, and the Mavericks held off the Timberwolves 120-114 in Minneapolis in the first rematch of last season's Western Conference finals.

● In San Francisco, **Buddy Hield** scored a season-best 28 points and the Warriors rallied from 17 down to beat the Pelicans 124-106. The Warriors were short-handed without starters **Stephen Curry** (ankle sprain) and **Andrew Wiggins** (lower back strain).

● The NBA fined the 76ers \$100,000 on Tuesday for public statements that "were inconsistent with **Joel Embiid**'s health status and in violation of NBA rules, including the league's Player Participation Policy."

● Veteran forward **Rudy Gay** announced in The Players' Tribune on Tuesday that he is retiring after 17 NBA seasons.

NFL: Colts bench Richardson

The Colts are benching **Anthony Richardson** to start **Joe Flacco** at quarterback on Sunday at Minnesota, two people with knowledge of the decision told The Associated Press.

● The Ravens acquired wide receiver **Diontae Johnson** and a sixth-round pick in 2025 from the Panthers for a 2025 fifth-rounder, a person familiar with the situation told the AP.

● The 1-year-old daughter of 49ers cornerback **Charvarius Ward** has died after battling heart problems since her birth. Ward posted on Instagram that his daughter, **Amani Joy**, died on Monday morning.

NHL: Wild defeat Penguins

Marc-Andre Fleury stopped 26 shots in what will likely be his final game in Pittsburgh as the Wild beat the Penguins 5-3. Fleury, 39, played the first 13 seasons for Pittsburgh with three Stanley Cup wins and indicated the 2024-25 season will be his last.
